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Community Aspiration Learning

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Collecting Children at the End of the Day

- Children must be collected from the **designated collection point** at the end of each day.
 - Parents can't collect children from other locations.
- Only Year 6 pupils can walk home alone written permission is required.
- Children can only be collected by **designated adults** (aged 16 or above).
- If you want your child to be collected by someone other than those who normally collect them, please phone the office during the day and inform Miss Hooper of your wish and the **password**.

School Uniform and PE Kit

- Boys uniform: grey jumper, white polo t-shirt, grey / black trousers and black trainers or shoes
 - Girls uniform: grey jumper or cardigan, white polo t-shirt, grey pinafore or grey / black trousers and black trainers or shoes; NO BOOTS or HEELS
 - Children **MUST** wear their PE kit to school on PE days. Boys and girls have the same PE kit.
 - PE Kit: Grey / black tracksuit bottoms, white polo t-shirt, and either the grey school PE jumper or a plain black hoodie. Children must wear trainers on the days when they have PE.
